TERMS and AGREEMENTS (initial each)

_____ I understand that because my child is part time, membership discounts do not apply to me.

_____ I understand that even though I am a part time parent, I am required to enroll under the 10 month contract. There is a \$100 Early Withdrawal Fee for any student withdrawing during the school year for any reason.

_____ I understand that because my child is part time, I must arrive for pick up no later than 1:15 p.m. Anytime after 1:15 p.m., parents will acquire a late fee of \$5 per minute.

_____ I understand that because my child is part time, I must provide lunch and snack for my child. If for any reason that my child doesn't come with his/her own lunch, lunch will be provided for my child for \$ 4.00 (which will be applied to your account).

_____ I understand that if for any reason I am unable to pick up my child on time for 3 consecutive days (exceeding the 15 minute grace period), I will be charged the full day, monthly rate at \$1,144.00.

Tuition payments are due on the first (1st) of each month beginning August 1, 2024 and ending May 1, 2025. Payments not received by the 15th of each month will be subject to a \$25 late fee (per family). All checks should be made payable to Victory Christian Center (VCC). Parents are expected to bring tuition payments or mail them directly to the school office. Our mailing address is P.O. Box 240433, Charlotte, NC 28224-0433. Payments may also be made by debit or major credit card.
